PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

As a player / participant and in addition to The Spirit of Cricket provisions, you must also meet the following requirements when participating in any game or competition held or sanctioned by Berowra Cricket Club, Hornsby Ku-ring-gai & Hills District Cricket Association or any sporting body affiliated with Cricket NSW or Cricket Australia:

1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of fellow players, umpires / officials and spectators.
2. Do not tolerate acts of aggression. In such circumstances you should make your umpire or your coach and/or manager aware of the events and retaliation is not acceptable under any circumstances.
3. Respect the talent, potential and development of fellow players and competitors.
4. Care for and respect the equipment provided to you as part of your team kit.
5. Be frank and honest with your coach and manager concerning illness and injury and your availability on game days.
6. Make yourself aware of the rules and regulations of the HK&HDCA competition that were supplied to your coaches and managers to be familiar with rules prior to the season's commencement. Likewise you should make yourself aware of the "Spirit of Cricket" provisions as issued by the MCC and adhere to them as intended.
7. Conduct yourself in a professional manner relating to language, temper and punctuality. Maintain high personal behavior standards at all times. Breaches of the standards as set out in (6) and (7) above will be referred to Berowra Cricket Club's Disciplinary Committee and has the potential to see the player banned from playing for the club. In such instances the matter may also be referred to the HK&HDCA, and/or Cricket NSW for further disciplinary action.
8. Abide by the rules and respect the decision of the umpire or official, making all appeals through the formal process and respecting the final decision.
